## Geography

### I. Economic, industrial, transport and service heritage directed at the region's development.

- **The history of oil mining**
  - a) the world's first oil mine (1854 Bóbrka)
  - b) the inventor of the kerosene lamp - Ignacy Łukasiewicz,
  - c) Europe's biggest collection of kerosene lamps in Krosno
- **Glass heritage** - Krosno
- **Aviation in Podkarpacie (Subcarpathian) Province** – the past and the present (the Aviation Valley), Rzeszów- Jasionka Airport - the easternmost international airport in the EU
- **Modern technologies** – Podkarpackie Science and Technology Park AEROPOLIS, Eastern Poland IT Companies Cluster, Lesser Poland/Subcarpathian Clean Energy Cluster

## Biology

### I. Podkarpacie natural heritage

- **The Bieszczady** – specimens protected in the Bieszczadzki National Park. The BNP as a part of the International Biosphere Reserve **'The Eastern Carpathians'** and campaign to include it on the UNESCO World Heritage List
- **Magura National Park** – a part of the Lower Beskids. The park has been selected as special habitat protection area within Natura 2000 Networking Programme

- Selected nature reserves of the voivodeship e.g. Lisia Góra Reserve

## History

### I. Historical heritage:

- Podkarpacie prehistory – a visit to the archeological open-air museum in Trzcinica Carpathian Troy)
- Magnate residences in Podkarpacie. Visits to the palaces in Łańcut, Krasieczyn and Baranów Sandomierski
- Podkarpacie battlefields – the ruins of the Przemyśl fortress, bunkers in Stępina
- The inhabitants of Podkarpacie over the centuries – a visit to the living history museum of folk architecture in Sanok
